YEAR 5 CHRISTMAS CRAFT SESSION




On Tuesday, Year 5 had a great craft session with their adults. They made their own advent calendars ready for the 1st of December. They decorated them with lots of Christmassy colours and

The World's Weirdest Places (Supernova)


