Please read below to find out more about Kathleen Kitchen

Mrs Kathleen Kitchen was an English teacher at Swain House Middle School in the 1980s. Her family circumstances were such that she had to leave school at fourteen without any qualifications. She was a cleaner and mill worker for many years but after having her family she returned to education in her late thirties by studying at Night School three nights a week in Leeds. Much later she was able to enrol at Margaret McMillan Teacher Training College in Bradford and qualified as a teacher. She began her first teaching job at the age of forty-four but continued studying part-time for further qualifications until her mid-sixties.

Kathleen was a teacher who took great pleasure in helping children to enjoy reading and going to the theatre. Many former pupils will remember squashing into the back of her very small car for trips to the Alhambra theatre in Bradford. Most of all she was a kind person who always watched out for the underdog or someone missing out on potential life chances.
